AN ACT

Section 1722-J. Department of Education.

The following shall apply to appropriations for the
Department of Education from the General Appropriation Act:

(12) (i) Each school district shall take such steps as
necessary during fiscal year 2009-2010 in order to have
or maintain a certified safety committee by December 31,
2010, for the purposes of section 1002(b) of the act of
June 2, 1915 (P.L.736, No.338), known as the Workers'
Compensation Act. The Department of Labor and Industry
shall provide the Department of Education with the list
of school districts who have a certified safety
committee. In the case of a school district that does not

submit evidence to the Department of Education that complies with this paragraph, the Department of Education shall deduct from any allocation from the Commonwealth to which the school district is entitled the amount of the discount the school district would otherwise receive under section 1002(b) of the Workers' Compensation Act.

(ii) Subparagraph (i) shall not apply to a school district that cannot receive a premium discount under section 1002(b) of the Workers' Compensation Act, or an equivalent reduction in contribution rates, by establishing and maintaining a certified safety committee because it is authorized to self-insure its liabilities under section 305 of the Workers' Compensation Act or pool its liabilities under section 802 of the Workers' Compensation Act.
